

2021 Rotary/Music in the Mountains Young Musicians Competition



Eligibility: Open to musicians in 3rd through 12th grade.

Registration Dates: Open January 1, 2021 thru March 5, 2021.

Competition Date: Competition videos due by Monday, March 15, 2021.

Judging: All student videos will be judged by professional musicians and will receive feedback on their performance.

Awards:

<u>Division Prizes:</u> 1st thru 3rd place monetary prizes for Levels 3 & 4. Paul Perry Award will be given to the best showcase performance.

<u>Rotary Prize:</u> open to an instrumental student in 9th through 12th grade who lives in and attends school in Western Nevada County (excluding the Truckee area). **Rotary winner also must compete at a district competition in the Tahoe area on May 1, 2021.**

Finalist Showcase: Finalists will be announced by the first week in April. Finalists will be asked to participate in a showcase on April 18, 2021.

Fee: \$15 for Division 1 and 2 \$25 for Division 3 and 4 (includes Rotary Competition) per entry Fee waivers available upon request.

MUSIC IN THE MOUNTAINS YOUNG MUSICIANS COMPETITION

The Young Musicians Competition (YMC) was first held in 1987. This competition provides the opportunity for instrumental music students, grades 3-12 to study, and perform classical, Broadway, jazz or other repertoire for professional judges. Participating students will each receive detailed written critiques from the adjudicators.

The Rotary Clubs of Western Nevada Country have been holding a music competition for the past 16 years. The winner of this additional award, as determined by our judges, must be a high school student (grades 9 – 12) who resides and attends school in Nevada County (excluding the Truckee area). The winner will represent Western Nevada County at the Rotary District Music Contest final competition on Saturday, April 25, 2020 at the Nugget Casino Resort, 1100 Nugget Avenue in Sparks, Nevada. The 3 district prizes are \$500, \$750, and \$1,000 (*winner must be available to go to Sparks for the competition).
